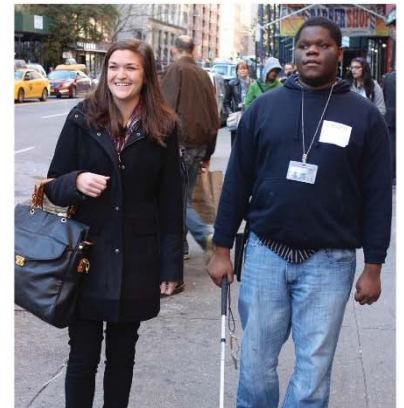
Donations will also assist our adults with disabilities as they plan their springtime activities.
